**Meeting Minutes**  
**March 11, 2016**

Present: Erik Barnes, Joanne Condosta, Dewey Auger, Don LaFontaine, Joe Hanzalik; Selectboard Representative Dan Cotter, Fran Shippee

Call to Order: Barnes called the meeting to order at 6:10 pm.

Parks & Rec Director: There was discussion on a proposal from Joanne Condosta for a new position – assistant Parks & Rec director. She would live in the cottage year round, do the ground work, plantings and offer quilting, crafting out of the cottage. Concerns that were raised on this proposal – housing is not considered taxable income to the director because it is a requirement of employment. This would not be the case on Condosta’s situation, the income would be reportable and taxable. Cotter thought that the selectboard would not approve this plan.

Nonpublic Session

Barnes will go to the selectboard meeting next Wednesday, 3/17 to present recommendation. Other options will also be discussed such as return to beach manager only for May 1<sup>st</sup> through soccer season employment with stipends paid for basketball and baseball managers. Finding the right manager or director is important. Barnes will talk to Carrier about a resume he already has and whether it is appropriate to submit it before others are received.

The next regular meeting will be held at the town office on Monday, April 4th at 6:00 pm.
