

**TOWN OF CHESTERFIELD

MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 2, 2014**

Present: Tom Duston, Chairman; Kathy Thatcher, Lynne Borofsky, Pam Walton, Steve Hardy and Amy LaFontaine

- 1). Communication – Tom presented a listing of contacts.

 - B). Bridge in Friedsam
- 2). Lynne moved to approve April 28th minutes as amended. The motion was seconded by Pam and passed unanimously.
- 3). Permits, Complaints – Sarah Hoag & Schroeder Wetlands & Non-Site Specific 2014-00583
- 4). Grants, Events – Date for Madame Sherri information to be completed. The current bridge was built in 2007. Lynne moved to spend up to \$3,000 from the Fund towards the replacement of Madame Sherri Bridge subject to our approval the first \$350 to come from the Forest Society. The motion was seconded by Pam and passed unanimously. The Commission will schedule a meeting for July 14th if necessary.
- 5). Spofford Lake Report – Pam moved to expend \$5,000 from the Conservation Fund to the Spofford Lake Association Lake Host Program. The motion was seconded by Kathy and passed unanimously.
- 6). Selectboard – Jon McKeon stepped in momentarily to report on the progress of the Town Lawsuit against the ZBA.
- 7). Tools – The registration for the CCC Trailer has expired. Steve will ask Rick if he has the expired registration.
- 8). Trail Development & Land Projects – The mailbox painted at the School has been completed. The gate at the end of Old Prouty Road has been damaged again. Tom moved to expend \$2,000 from the Conservation Fund to repair the gate on old Swanzey Road. The motion did not get seconded. The other members wished to wait to see if the Madame Sherri expenditure will be needed.
- 9). Tom moved to enter non-public session per RSA 91-A:3. The motion was seconded by Pam and passed unanimously.

Pam reported that there was significant vandalism to Pierce Island. The reason for being non-public was to protect the investigation.

Tom moved to exit non-public session and seal the minutes. The motion was seconded by Pam and passed unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 9:05 PM.
